

Ways to Help Win 100% Clean Energy in NYS by 2030

1. Get State Legislators to **co-sponsor the state bill** for 100% clean energy by 2030. A7497 / S6627. Meet with your state legislators. (Sponsors as of 6/19 - Assembly: Colton, Ortiz, Mosley, Skartados, Cook, Rosenthal, Blake, Glick, Hooper, Kearns, Simon, Thiele; Senate: Hoylman, Perkins)

2. Get Organizations to **endorse** the campaign legislation. Set a personal goal of getting of 5, 10, 25 organizations. We presently have 80 endorsers. We want to increase it to 200. We want more unions and faith groups.



3. **Climate Action Plan** on how your community will move to 100% clean energy - with detailed steps, timelines and benchmarks.

4. Write **letters** to the editor. (And to the Governor and legislators.) See gelfny.org for samples.

5. **Volunteer** for the campaign. Be a local coordinator. We need help with media, graphics, writing, organizing, social media, fundraising.

6. **Donate** to GELF and the Campaign for 100% Clean Energy. Send checks to GELF, 315 Greene Ave 2B, Brooklyn NY 11238.

7. Do **public speaking** on clean energy. To groups, community meetings, talk shows. Help educate the public about climate change. Info and handouts on gelfny.org.

8. Create a **local group** to promote 100% by 2030 campaign. Or add a committee to an existing climate change action group. Hold regular meetings to divide up tasks.

9. **Support the work of other climate change activists** and organizations. Support the campaigns for divestment and carbon tax. Say no to any \$ for fossil fuels. Support grassroots efforts that oppose fossil fuel infrastructure. Support Sierra Club and Beyond Coal. Climate Mobilization. PCM NY. 350org/NYC. Renewables NY. Sane Energy. AGREE. Green Party. Etc. (check out gelfny.org/faq/organizations/)

10. **Reduce your carbon footprint** - by individual and community action. Reduce energy use. Support Solarize initiatives. Support Community Choice Aggregation. Promote organic

11. Promote a **Just Transition and Energy Democracy**. Connect with other movements for economic and social justice.

12. Demand that **candidates pledge** to support 100% clean energy ASAP.

13. **Challenge everyone to do more**. We can debate whether it is possible to go to 100% clean energy by 2025, 2030, or 2050. What we can't debate is that we have to get there ASAP and we have to start NOW. When elected officials propose incremental steps to get us there. publicly say we need faster action.
